Why do I need to complete a swim test? Rowing is a water sport and while the possibility of falling in the water is relatively low, it is still a risk. Each AJR member must prove his/her ability to swim. Before you are permitted to row with AJR, you must provide a written record that a certified lifeguard has observed your ability to swim 100 yards and remain afloat (tread water) for 5 minutes. There are no exceptions to this policy. If you are a lifeguard, please provide a copy of your certification.	
AJR members may take their swim test at any pool that has a certified lifeguard or water safety instructor. Tests are given at the Anne Arundel Olympic Swim Center on Riva Road for a nominal entry fee. Tell the attendant at the front desk that you need to have a lifeguard verify your ability to swim 100 yards without stopping and tread water for 5 minutes.
